The Rev'd Canon James Callaway is CUAC's General Secretary Emeritus and has served as Friends Treasurer since 2011. He has known Cuttinton since meeting Bishop George Brown of Liberia in 1973 and became a frequent visitor to Monrovia and Suakoko. Jamie was longtime Deputy for Grants at Trinity Church, who made the church in Africa their international focus in 1984. His extensive travel there included South Africa, where Trinity developed a program emphasis to Overcome Apartheid, supporting Bishop Desmond Tutu's work, among that of many others. In 2015 LECUSA presented the Bishop Bravid W. Harris Education Award (he and his wife had known the bishop's widow Flossie Harris in New York for over a decade) and, 2016 he received the Cross of Saint Augustine for his contributions to the Anglican Communion. He lives in New York City with his wife, Dr. Mary Chilton Callaway, a professor of Old Testament at Fordham University.
